BASIC SECURITY GUARD CERTIFICATION

SECURITY GUARD PREPARATION



This course trains and prepares students for national certification in basic security guard skills. Detailed training is aligned with IFPO & PSTN standards satisfying Chapter 463 of the Hawaii Revised Statute. Students will learn a variety of skills, including: security measures to minimize property loss, secure work environments and conduct investigations, evaluate surroundings and enact proper emergency response.

This course is an overview of security guard training topics as required in Chapter 463 of the Hawaii Revised Statute. This course is designed for people who are currently employed in a security position and seeking training to meet upcoming state requirements. Students will review topics covered in the 40 hour certification course entitled Basic Security Guard Certification.
