BIOFUELS OPERATOR

COURSE HOURS 228 **TUITION** \$2,800

Prepares participants to work as plant process operators, technicians, or control specialists at biodiesel production facilities.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS 18 yrs. or older, recommended: high school diploma or equivalent, 8th grade math, 9th grade reading, physical exam clearance

PROCESS PLANT OPERATOR

COURSE HOURS 528 **TUITION** \$6,995

Learn skills which help gain employment in any of several process sectors: petrochemical refining, oil and gas production, pharmaceutical manufacturing, food and beverage processing, and alternative energy.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS 18 yrs. or older, recommended: high school diploma or equivalent, 8th grade math, 9th grade reading, physical exam clearance



HOME ENERGY SURVEY PROFESSIONAL

COURSE HOURS 48 **TUITION** \$2,000

This course will provide students with training in energy efficiency and building science, and will prepare them to take the nationally recognized RESNET Home Energy Survey Professional test.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS 16 yrs. or older, recommended: 6th grade math and reading level

INTRODUCTION TO GREEN BUILDING AND ENERGY MANAGEMENT

COURSE HOURS 32 **TUITION** \$2,000

This course will give participants a strong foundation in understanding green building strategies that work in Hawaii. Topics include green materials, building techniques, air quality, water conservation and energy efficiency. The class will finish with a one day LEED Green Associate (GA) Exam Preparation workshop which ties the class to a nationally recognized designation.
